9 **** Section 1.** AS 11.41 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 **Sec. 11.41.310. Human trafficking in the first degree.** (a) A person commits
11 the crime of human trafficking in the first degree if the person compels or induces
12 another person to come to this state to engage in sexual conduct, adult entertainment,
13 or labor in the state by force or threat of force against any person, or by deception.

14 (b) In this section,

15 (1) "adult entertainment" means the conduct described in

16 AS 23.10.350(f)(1) - (3);

17 (2) "deception" has the meaning given in AS 11.46.180;

18 (3) "sexual conduct" has the meaning given in AS 11.66.150.

19 (c) Human trafficking in the first degree is a class A felony.

20 **Sec. 11.41.315. Human trafficking in the second degree.** (a) A person
21 commits the crime of human trafficking in the second degree if the person obtains a
22 benefit from the commission of human trafficking under AS 11.41.310, with reckless
23 disregard that the benefit is a result of the trafficking.

1 (b) Human trafficking in the second degree is a class B felony.

2 * **Sec. 2.** AS 11.66.120(a) is amended to read:

3 (a) A person commits the crime of promoting prostitution in the second degree
4 if the person

5 (1) manages, supervises, controls, or owns, either alone or in
6 association with others, a prostitution enterprise other than a place of prostitution;
7 [OR]

8 (2) procures or solicits a patron for a prostitute; or

9 (3) offers, sells, advertises, promotes, or facilitates travel that
10 includes commercial sexual conduct as enticement for the travel; in this
11 paragraph, "commercial sexual conduct" means sexual conduct for which
12 anything of value is given or received by any person."
