3 **** Section 1.** AS 18.80.060(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) In addition to the other powers and duties prescribed by this chapter, the
5 commission shall

6 (1) appoint an executive director approved by the governor;

7 (2) hire other administrative staff as may be necessary to the
8 commission's function;

9 (3) exercise general supervision and direct the activities of the
10 executive director and other administrative staff;

11 (4) accept complaints under AS 18.80.100;

12 (5) study the problems of discrimination in all or specific fields of
13 human relationships, foster through community effort or goodwill, cooperation and
14 conciliation among the groups and elements of the population of the state, and publish
15 results of investigations and research as in its judgment will tend to eliminate
16 discrimination because of race, religion, color, national ancestry, physical or mental
17 disability, age, sex, marital status, changes in marital status, pregnancy, or parenthood;

18 (6) make an overall assessment, at least once every three years, of the
19 progress made toward equal employment opportunity by every department of state
20 government; results of the assessment shall be included in the annual report made
21 under AS 18.80.150;

22 (7) annually study the demographics of the application of the
23 primary seat belt law provided for in AS 28.05.095(a) and compile a report that

1 identifies who and what groups are being found to be in violation of the law and
2 identifies the violations by areas of the state; the commission shall include this
3 report with its annual report to the legislature required by AS 18.80.150."
