A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to an application for a permanent fund dividend for a member of the**
 2 **armed forces of the United States serving on active duty outside of the state; and**
 3 **providing for an effective date."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 43.23.015(d) is amended to read:

6 (d) The application and certification of residency of an unemancipated
 7 individual under 18 years of age or of a disabled or an incompetent individual must be
 8 signed by the individual's parent, legal guardian, or other authorized representative.
 9 **An individual may complete, sign, and file an application on behalf of a member**
 10 **of the armed forces of the United States who is serving on active duty outside of**
 11 **the United States if the individual has a power of attorney from the member of**
 12 **the armed forces that authorizes, in specific or general terms, the individual to**
 13 **file that application.**

14 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect January 1, 2006.
