A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to alcohol server education."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 04.21.025(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) The subjects that are included in an approved alcohol server education
 5 course shall be determined under regulations adopted by the board. In approving
 6 alcohol server education courses, the board shall consider the needs of both urban and
 7 rural licensees regarding access to an approved alcohol server education course. A
 8 licensee, agent, or employee who sells or serves alcoholic beverages shall keep **the**
 9 **card described in (c) of this section or other** proof acceptable to the board of
 10 successful completion of an approved alcohol server education course on the licensed
 11 premises during working hours.

12 * **Sec. 2.** AS 04.21.025(c) is amended to read:

13 (c) A licensee, agent, or employee shall complete the course required under (a)
 14 of this section **and pass a written test demonstrating an understanding of the**
 15 **course subjects** not more than 30 days after being licensed or employed. **The course**

1 **provider shall issue a card to each individual who completes the course and**
2 **passes the written test. A card issued under this subsection is valid for three**
3 **years from the date of issue. A licensee, agent, or employee may renew a card**
4 **issued under this section; to renew the card, the licensee, agent, or employee must**
5 **pass a written test demonstrating an understanding of the course subjects.**
