A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to tourist accommodations permits and to penalties for failing to
2 comply with permitting requirements; removing a requirement that persons operating
3 tourist accommodations post certain laws and regulations on the premises; and
4 providing for an effective date."

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

6 * **Section 1.** AS 18.35.080 is amended to read:

7 **Sec. 18.35.080. Penalty for noncompliance.** A person who fails to comply
8 with AS 18.35.010 - 18.35.090 [, EXCEPT AS 18.35.040,] or the regulations adopted
9 under those sections, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not more than \$100,
10 or by imprisonment in a jail for not more than 30 days, or both.

11 * **Sec. 2.** AS 18.35.040, 18.35.050, 18.35.070; and AS 44.64.030(a)(16) are repealed.

12 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
