A RESOLUTION

1 **Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State**
2 **Legislature, concerning Senate Bill No. 141, relating to the teachers' and public**
3 **employees' retirement systems and creating defined contribution and health**
4 **reimbursement plans for members of the teachers' retirement system and the public**
5 **employees' retirement system who are first hired after July 1, 2005; relating to**
6 **university retirement programs; establishing the Alaska Retirement Management Board**
7 **to replace the Alaska State Pension Investment Board, the Alaska Teachers' Retirement**
8 **Board, and the Public Employees' Retirement Board; adding appeals of the decisions of**
9 **the administrator of the teachers' and public employees' retirement systems to the**
10 **jurisdiction of the office of administrative hearings; providing for nonvested members of**
11 **the teachers' retirement system defined benefit plans to transfer into the teachers'**
12 **retirement system defined contribution plan and for nonvested members of the public**
13 **employees' retirement system defined benefit plans to transfer into the public**

1 **employees' retirement system defined contribution plan; providing for political**
2 **subdivisions and public organizations to request to participate in the public employees'**
3 **defined contribution retirement plan; and providing for an effective date.**

4 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of
6 Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding
7 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of Senate Bill No. 141, relating to
8 the teachers' and public employees' retirement systems and creating defined contribution and
9 health reimbursement plans for members of the teachers' retirement system and the public
10 employees' retirement system who are first hired after July 1, 2005; relating to university
11 retirement programs; establishing the Alaska Retirement Management Board to replace the
12 Alaska State Pension Investment Board, the Alaska Teachers' Retirement Board, and the
13 Public Employees' Retirement Board; adding appeals of the decisions of the administrator of
14 the teachers' and public employees' retirement systems to the jurisdiction of the office of
15 administrative hearings; providing for nonvested members of the teachers' retirement system
16 defined benefit plans to transfer into the teachers' retirement system defined contribution plan
17 and for nonvested members of the public employees' retirement system defined benefit plans
18 to transfer into the public employees' retirement system defined contribution plan; providing
19 for political subdivisions and public organizations to request to participate in the public
20 employees' defined contribution retirement plan; and providing for an effective date.
