A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to consideration by the Local Boundary Commission of a requested**
2 **borough incorporation."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 44.33.812(a) is amended to read:

5 (a) The Local Boundary Commission shall

6 (1) make studies of local government boundary problems;

7 (2) adopt regulations providing standards and procedures for municipal
8 incorporation, annexation, detachment, merger, consolidation, reclassification, and
9 dissolution;

10 (3) consider a local government boundary change requested of it by the
11 legislature, the commissioner of commerce, community, and economic development,
12 or a political subdivision of the state; **"boundary change" may not be construed to**
13 **include a borough incorporation;** and

14 (4) develop standards and procedures for the extension of services and

1 ordinances of incorporated cities into contiguous areas for limited purposes upon
2 majority approval of the voters of the contiguous area to be annexed and prepare
3 transition schedules and prorated tax mill levies as well as standards for participation
4 by voters of these contiguous areas in the affairs of the incorporated cities furnishing
5 services.
