A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act making appropriations from the earnings reserve account for construction of**
2 **an integrated science complex at the University of Alaska in Anchorage, for replacement**
3 **of the virology laboratory in Fairbanks, for expansion of the Anchorage Museum of**
4 **History and Art, for the major maintenance grant fund, and for other capital projects**
5 **related to education; and providing for an effective date."**

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

7 * **Section 1.** EDUCATION AND EARLY DEVELOPMENT MAJOR MAINTENANCE.
8 The sum of \$141,800,817 is appropriated from the earnings reserve account (AS 37.13.145) to
9 the major maintenance grant fund (AS 14.11.007) for payment as grants under AS 14.11.007
10 by the Department of Education and Early Development for K-12 capital improvement major
11 maintenance projects for the fiscal year ending in 2006.

12 * **Sec. 2.** EDUCATION AND EARLY DEVELOPMENT CAPITAL PROJECTS. The
13 following sums are appropriated from the earnings reserve account (AS 37.13.145) to the

1 school construction grant fund (AS 14.11.005) for payment as grants under AS 14.11.005 by
 2 the Department of Education and Early Development to the following municipalities and
 3 regional educational attendance areas for the following projects:

6 * **Sec. 3.** HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES. The sum of \$24,200,000 is appropriated
7 from the earnings reserve account (AS 37.13.145) to the Department of Health and Social
8 Services for replacement of the virology laboratory in Fairbanks.

9 * **Sec. 4.** UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA. (a) The sum of \$71,600,000 is appropriated from
10 the earnings reserve account (AS 37.13.145) to the University of Alaska for the construction
11 of phase one and phase two of an integrated science facility in Anchorage.

12 (b) The sum of \$7,500,000 is appropriated from the earnings reserve account
13 (AS 37.13.145) to the University of Alaska for Kenai Peninsula College student housing.

14 (c) The sum of \$3,000,000 is appropriated from the earnings reserve account
15 (AS 37.13.145) to the University of Alaska for Kenai Peninsula College classroom additions.

16 (d) The sum of \$500,000 is appropriated from the earnings reserve account
17 (AS 37.13.145) to the University of Alaska for the Kenai Cultural Arts and Research Center.

18 (e) The sum of \$1,500,000 is appropriated from the earnings reserve account
19 (AS 37.13.145) to the University of Alaska for Matanuska-Susitna campus planning.

20 (f) The sum of \$1,200,000 is appropriated from the earnings reserve account
21 (AS 37.13.145) to the University of Alaska Fairbanks for the Bristol Bay Campus south
22 addition.

23 * **Sec. 5.** ANCHORAGE MUSEUM OF HISTORY AND ART. The sum of \$5,000,000 is
24 appropriated from the earnings reserve account (AS 37.13.145) to the Department of
25 Commerce, Community, and Economic Development for payment as a grant to the
26 Municipality of Anchorage for the Anchorage Museum of History and Art expansion.

27 * **Sec. 6.** The appropriations made by this Act are for capital projects and lapse under
28 AS 37.25.020.

29 * **Sec. 7.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2005.
