A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act establishing Older Alaskans' Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.100. Older Alaskans' Day.** The second Wednesday of September
5 of each year is established as Older Alaskans' Day to honor residents of the state who
6 are 60 years of age or older for the many contributions made by older Alaskans to the
7 state. The day may be celebrated by public ceremonies and by quiet appreciation.
