ANALYSIS: (Attach a separate page if necessary)

This legislation re-criminalizes the possession of certain amounts of marijuana that previously have been legal to possess. While the criminalization of conduct currently legal is expected increase case loads, the Agency does have the statistical data to predict with any certainty what that increase would be.

The proposed bill also amends the crime of manslaughter to include deaths that are the direct result of ingesting drugs knowingly manufactured or delivered illegally; amends the crime of child endangerment to include a C felony for manufacturing methamphetamine in a building where children reside; and raises to an A felony possession of methamphetamine in an organic solution.

Based upon the new crimes and increased penalties, the Agency submits an indeterminate fiscal note.
