This bill adds language to AS 28.35.185(a) requiring the driver of a vehicle to safely vacate the lane closest to a tow truck in the act of picking up a vehicle or an animal control vehicle being used to perform official duties on a highway or roadway.

This is in addition to the list of vehicles that require drivers operating in two or more lanes traveling in the same direction to safely vacate the lane closest to these vehicles, unless directed by law enforcement or emergency personnel.

There will be no fiscal impact to the Department of Public Safety by passage of this legislation.
