This legislation imposes a number of new requirements on State government regarding the protection of personal information, such as Social Security numbers. For example, the bill prohibits the transmission of Social Security numbers via the Internet unless encrypted or otherwise secured. The bill also would prohibit State agencies from collecting Social Security numbers unless specifically authorized by State or federal law.

It appears that State agencies could incur significant costs to comply with this legislation. The total of these costs cannot be accurately projected at this time.
