ANALYSIS: (Attach a separate page if necessary)

CSSB 284(JUD) allows a judge to prohibit a person from consuming alcohol for up to the life of the person if the person has been convicted of a felony crime against a person under AS 11.41 or certain DUI and refusal offenses. The bill makes it a class A misdemeanor to violate an order not to consume alcohol. It will be a class C felony if a person has been previously convicted of this crime. This bill will impact the court system because it will result in new misdemeanor and felony charges being filed against those who violate this new crime. However, because it is not clear how often this new sentencing option will be imposed or how often it will be violated and prosecuted, the extent of the impact is too speculative to support a fiscal note at this time.
