1 Page 11, after Line 10 add the following intent language:

2 "A school district may not receive state education aid for K-12 support appropriated
3 under Section 1 of this Act and distributed by the Department of Education and Early
4 Development under AS 14.17 if the school district

5 (1) has a policy refusing to allow recruiters for any branch of the United States
6 military, Reserve Officers' Training Corps, Central Intelligence Agency, or Federal
7 Bureau of Investigation to contact students on a school campus if the school district
8 allows college, vocational school, or other job recruiters on a campus to contact students;

9 (2) refuses to allow the Boy Scouts of America to use school facilities for
10 meetings or contact with students if the school makes the facility available to other non-
11 school groups in the community; or

12 (3) has a policy of refusing to have an in-school Reserve Officers' Training Corps
13 program or a Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps program."
