A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to the district cost factors for state funding of public education;**
 2 **providing for an effective date by repealing the delayed effective date of sec. 6, ch. 41,**
 3 **SLA 2006; and providing for an effective date."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 *** Section 1.** AS 14.17.460(a) is amended to read:

19 * **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
20 read:

21 RETROACTIVITY. If this Act takes effect after July 1, 2007, it is retroactive to
22 July 1, 2007.

23 * **Sec. 4.** Section 11, ch. 41, SLA 2006, providing an effective date for AS 14.17.460(a), as
24 amended by sec. 6, ch. 41, SLA 2006, is repealed.

25 * **Sec. 5.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
