A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act decreasing the fee for a business license; relating to a civil fine for not having a
2 current business license; and providing for an effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 43.70.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (e) If a person knowingly engages in a business in the state without having a
6 current license issued under (a) of this section, the department may impose a civil fine
7 of up to \$100. In this subsection, "knowingly" has the meaning given in AS 11.81.900.

8 * **Sec. 2.** AS 43.70.030(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) The fee for each business license is \$25 a [\$100 PER] year [, EXCEPT
10 THAT THE FEE IS \$50 IF

11 (1) THE BUSINESS IS A SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP; AND

12 (2) THE SOLE PROPRIETOR IS 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER
13 WHEN THE SOLE PROPRIETOR APPLIES FOR THE LICENSE OR WILL
14 REACH 65 YEARS OF AGE AT ANY TIME DURING THE YEAR FOR WHICH

- 1 THE LICENSE IS ISSUED].
- 2 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect October 1, 2008.
