**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to the video recording and audio recording by a business of the inside**  
2 **or outside of its business location."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 45.45 is amended by adding a new section to article 12 to read:

5 **Sec. 45.45.940. Business video recording and audio recording.** (a) A person  
6 who is engaged in a business at a location that is open to the public may not make a  
7 video recording or an audio recording of the person's business customers on the inside  
8 or outside of the business premises unless the person has posted on the premises a sign  
9 stating that the person is making the video recording or audio recording.

10 (b) The sign required by (a) of this section must be at least 11 inches by 14  
11 inches in size, and the lettering must be at least one-half inch high and in a contrasting  
12 color to the rest of the sign.

13 (c) A person who violates (a) of this section is guilty of a class B  
14 misdemeanor.
