A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to charter school funding."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 14.17.905(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) Notwithstanding (a)(3) of this section, a charter school shall be counted as
5 a separate school if the charter school has an ADM of at least **100** [150] students,
6 except that, in the first two years after a charter school is approved by the
7 department, a charter school shall be counted as a separate school even if it has
8 an ADM of fewer than 100 students.
