A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**1 **"An Act relating to impersonating a public servant."**2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**3 * **Section 1.** AS 11.56 is amended by adding a new section to read:4 **Sec. 11.56.827. Impersonating a public servant in the first degree.** (a) A
5 person commits the crime of impersonating a public servant in the first degree if the
6 person violates AS 11.56.830 by pretending to be a peace officer and purports to
7 exercise the authority of a peace officer in relation to another person.

8 (b) Impersonating a public servant in the first degree is a class C felony.

9 * **Sec. 2.** AS 11.56.830(a) is amended to read:10 (a) A person commits the crime of impersonating a public servant **in the**
11 **second degree** if the person pretends to be a public servant and **purports to exercise**
12 **the authority of a public servant in relation to another person** [DOES ANY ACT
13 IN THAT CAPACITY].14 * **Sec. 3.** AS 11.56.830(d) is amended to read:15 (d) Impersonating a public servant **in the second degree** is a class B

1 misdemeanor.

2 * **Sec. 4.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
3 read:

4 **APPLICABILITY.** AS 11.56.827, added by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to offenses
5 committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
