A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act eliminating the limit on compassionate gifts that a legislator or legislative
2 employee may solicit, accept, or receive under the Legislative Ethics Act; and providing
3 for an effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 24.60.075(c) is amended to read:

6 (c) [A LEGISLATOR OR LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEE MAY NOT
7 SOLICIT, ACCEPT, OR RECEIVE, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY,
8 COMPASSIONATE GIFTS WORTH LESS THAN \$250 THAT IN A CALENDAR
9 YEAR AGGREGATE TO \$250 OR MORE IN VALUE AND ARE FROM THE
10 SAME PERSON.] A legislator or legislative employee who receives a compassionate
11 gift, directly or indirectly, shall disclose to the committee the name of the gift's source
12 and the value of the gift within 30 days after receipt.

13 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
