FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to educational requirements for licensure as a certified public
 2 accountant."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 08.04.120(b) is amended to read:

5 (b) Notwithstanding (a) of this section, the board may grant a license to an
 6 applicant who has

7 (1) not completed the 150-hour educational program required by (a) of
 8 this section if the applicant has received a baccalaureate degree, or its equivalent,
 9 before January 1, 2001, from a college or university acceptable to the board, and if the
 10 applicant satisfies the other criteria established by the board by regulation for
 11 receiving the license; or

12 (2) completed a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent, before
 13 January 1, 2008, from a college or university acceptable to the board, and
 14 additional semester hours of postbaccalaureate study so that the total educational

1 program includes at least 150 hours, and the applicant has three years of
2 accounting experience satisfactory to the board.
