**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Establishing a legislative task force to make recommendations regarding job**  
2 **descriptions and salary changes for the commissioners and support staff and the**  
3 **possible need for additional support staff of the Regulatory Commission of Alaska.**

4 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 **WHEREAS** there is a need to evaluate the current job descriptions and salaries of the  
6 commissioners and support staff of the Regulatory Commission of Alaska; and

7 **WHEREAS** increased duties have been given to the commissioners; and

8 **WHEREAS** the Regulatory Commission of Alaska may need additional support staff;

9 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Alaska State Legislature that there is established a  
10 legislative task force to make recommendations regarding job descriptions and salary changes  
11 for the commissioners and support staff and the possible need for additional support staff of  
12 the Regulatory Commission of Alaska; and be it

13 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the task force shall be composed of nine members as  
14 follows:

15 (1) two majority members of the House of Representatives appointed by the

1 presiding officer;

2 (2) one minority member of the House of Representatives appointed by the  
3 presiding officer;

4 (3) two majority members of the Senate appointed by the presiding officer;

5 (4) one minority member of the Senate appointed by the presiding officer;

6 (5) the attorney general or the attorney general's designee;

7 (6) the commissioner of the Department of Commerce, Community, and  
8 Economic Development or the commissioner's designee; and

9 (7) the governor or the governor's designee; and be it

10 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the task force may meet between legislative sessions;  
11 and be it

12 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the legislative task force shall select a chair from the  
13 members of the legislature on the task force; and be it

14 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the staff of the legislative task force shall make a final  
15 report of its findings and recommendations to the legislature not later than February 1, 2008;  
16 and be it

17 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the task force is terminated May 30, 2008.
