A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to sport fishing services and sport fishing guide services."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 *** Section 1.** AS 16.40.260(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) A person may not provide sport fishing services unless the person

5 (1) holds a current sport fishing operator license and has current
6 insurance coverage as required in (a)(2) of this section; **or**

7 (2) is hired by a business to provide services to clients or potential
8 clients of that business if the clients or potential clients being provided with the
9 sport fishing services do not pay a portion of the cost of the services; in this
10 paragraph,

11 (A) "business" means a corporation, company, partnership,
12 firm, association, organization, business trust, or society that is licensed to
13 do business in this state;

14 (B) "cost of the services" means all costs associated with
15 sport fishing services, excluding transportation costs to and from the state.

1 * **Sec. 2.** AS 16.40.270(c) is amended to read:

2 (c) A person may not provide sport fishing guide services unless the person

3 (1) holds

4 (A) a current sport fishing guide license; and

5 (B) [(2) HOLDS] a current sport fishing operator license or is
6 an employee of a person who holds a current sport fishing operator license; or

7 (2) is hired by a business to provide services to clients or potential
8 clients of that business if the clients or potential clients being provided with the
9 sport fishing guide services do not pay a portion of the cost of the services; in this
10 paragraph,

11 (A) "business" has the meaning given in
12 AS 16.40.260(b)(2);

13 (B) "cost of the services" has the meaning given in
14 AS 16.40.260(b)(2).
