**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act decreasing the fee for a business license; and providing for an effective date."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 **\* Section 1.** AS 43.70.030(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) The fee for each business license is \$25 [\$100] per year [, EXCEPT THAT  
5 THE FEE IS \$50 IF

6 (1) THE BUSINESS IS A SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP; AND

7 (2) THE SOLE PROPRIETOR IS 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER  
8 WHEN THE SOLE PROPRIETOR APPLIES FOR THE LICENSE OR WILL  
9 REACH 65 YEARS OF AGE AT ANY TIME DURING THE YEAR FOR WHICH  
10 THE LICENSE IS ISSUED].

11 **\* Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect October 1, 2008.
