A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to per diem for the legislative branch and prohibiting legislators who**
2 **reside in the state capital from receiving per diem during sessions; and providing for an**
3 **effective date."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 24.10.130(b) is amended to read:

6 (b) Legislators and officers and employees of the legislative branch of
7 government are entitled to a per diem allowance **if authorized by the policy adopted**
8 **under (c) of this section, except that a legislator who resides in the state capital**
9 **may not receive a per diem allowance while the legislature is in regular or special**
10 **session.**

11 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
