A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to access to employment records by municipalities and to municipal**
2 **impoundment and forfeiture."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 23.20.110 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (r) The department shall provide information obtained under this chapter to a
6 municipal attorney to assist the municipality in the collection of civil or criminal fines,
7 penalties, or other payments or judgments ordered by a court. The department shall not
8 release information under this section to a municipal attorney until the department and
9 the municipal attorney have entered into a written agreement that governs the release
10 of information. The written agreement must specify

11 (1) the purpose for the information;

12 (2) a description of the information to be provided;

13 (3) a description of the procedure for transmitting, securing, using, and
14 disposing of the information; and

1 (4) the method of reimbursement for the cost of providing the
2 information.

3 * **Sec. 2.** AS 28.01.015(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) Notwithstanding other provisions in this title, a municipality may adopt an
5 ordinance providing for the impoundment or forfeiture of a

6 (1) motor vehicle, watercraft, or aircraft involved in the commission of
7 an offense under AS 28.35.030, 28.35.032, or an ordinance with elements substantially
8 similar to AS 28.35.030 or 28.35.032;

9 (2) motor vehicle involved in the commission of an offense under
10 AS 28.15.291 or an ordinance with elements similar to AS 28.15.291;

11 (3) motor vehicle used by a person whose license is suspended under
12 AS 28.22.041; [OR]

13 (4) motor vehicle used by a person who fails to carry proof of
14 insurance as required under AS 28.22.019; **or**

15 **(5) motor vehicle used by a person who has \$1,000 or more in**
16 **delinquent traffic fines for violations committed within the municipality.**

17 * **Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
18 read:

19 SEVERABILITY. Under AS 01.10.030, if any provision of this Act, or the application
20 of it to any person or circumstance, is held invalid, the remainder of this Act and the
21 application to other persons or circumstances are not affected.
