FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to an aggravating factor at sentencing for crimes directed at a victim**
2 **because of the victim's homelessness."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 12.55.155(c)(22) is amended to read:

5 (22) the defendant knowingly directed the conduct constituting the
6 offense at a victim because of that person's race, sex, color, creed, physical or mental
7 disability, ancestry, homelessness, or national origin;

8 * **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
9 read:

10 **APPLICABILITY.** This Act applies to offenses committed on or after the effective
11 date of this Act.
