This bill provides for the safe surrender of infants whereby the parent may not be criminally prosecuted for surrendering an infant in the manner described.

Drawing on other states' experience with similar laws, the OCS believes that adequate public education is key to success. If the desired effect of this bill is to stop abandonment of babies, the public needs to be made aware of their options. This fiscal note would cover estimated costs for a campaign that provides for media advertising, brochures, posters, etc., to be distributed in hospitals, clinics, doctors' offices, public assistance offices, and other public areas.
