Municipalities are authorized under AS 28.01.015(a) to adopt local ordinances for impoundment or forfeiture of vehicles for certain reasons. This bill adds the provision that Municipalities may adopt a local ordinances for impoundment or forfeiture of vehicles used by a person who has \$1,000 or more in unpaid traffic fines.

This bill will have no fiscal impact on the Division. If any municipality wishes assistance in the drafting of model ordinances for adoption by reference of this provision, as provided in AS 28.01.010(b), the Division would provide this assistance with existing staff.
