CSHB 255(FIN) expands the existing dual sentencing provisions for minors charged with certain offenses. The Division of Juvenile Justice estimates that it will refer to the district attorneys an average of 10 to 20 cases a year with a recommendation that the DA seek a dual sentence. Because of the small number of cases involved, the court system will be able to handle these cases without the need for any additional funds.
