AS 47.25.071 authorizes the Child Care Grant Program, which provides assistance for the operation of child care facilities. Under current law, grants to qualifying providers are adjusted on a geographic basis by the same factor as funding for a school district. Grants are also capped at \$50 per month for each qualifying child.

The Department does not anticipate that the changes to the school district cost factors in Section 5 of HB 273 will have a significant fiscal impact on the Child Care Grant Program as the proposal does not remove the \$50 monthly cap for each qualifying child.
