Section 1: This bill allows for 40 to 60 hours of time to make a bone marrow donation without taking leave. The effect of this legislation could only be measured in terms of productivity loss. The bill's maximum of 60 hours equals a 3% loss of productivity per donating employee (based on 60hrs / 1950 total working hours per year = 3%). It is expected that the number of employees taking advantage of the program would be extremely small. However, we do not have any statistics that back up a hard number.
