SCR 21 establishes a 10 member Cook Inlet Salmon Task Force as a Joint Legislative Task Force. The Presiding Officers will each appoint 5 members from their respective houses. They will jointly appoint the Chair and Vice Chair of the Task Force. The Task Force will examine conservation, allocation, economic, legal and constitutional issues related to Cook Inlet fisheries issues. The Task Force will be staffed by professional assistants to the Presiding Officers. The Task Force will submit a report to the Legislature on the first day of the First Regular Session of the 26th Legislature. Expenses for the Task Force will be absorbed within existing Legislative budgets. The Task Force terminates on February 1, 2009.
