A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act amending the termination date of the statewide boating safety and education
 2 program; providing for an effective date by amending the effective date of secs. 3, 5, 7, 9,
 3 11, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 26, and 27, ch. 28, SLA 2000, as amended; and providing for an
 4 effective date."

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

6 * **Section 1.** Section 30, ch. 28, SLA 2000, as amended by sec. 3, ch. 34, SLA 2004, is
 7 amended to read:

8 Sec. 30. Sections 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 26, and 27 of this Act take
 9 effect on the earlier of the following dates:

10 (1) July 1, 2011 [2010]; or

11 (2) 90 days after the date the chair of the Alaska Legislative Council
 12 notifies the revisor of statutes that in the previous state fiscal year the state did not
 13 receive and does not anticipate receiving federal funding for a statewide boating and
 14 safety education program; the director of the division of legislative finance shall notify

1 the chair of the Alaska Legislative Council when the state, in the previous fiscal year,
2 did not receive federal funding for a statewide boating and safety program; the chair of
3 the Alaska Legislative Council may not give the notice described in this paragraph
4 unless the notice is approved by a vote of a majority of the members of the Alaska
5 Legislative Council.

6 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
