A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the expiration date of a concealed handgun permit."

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 18.65.700(d) is amended to read:

4 (d) A permit issued under (a) of this section expires on the person's birthday
5 in the fifth year following issuance of the permit. The department may adjust the
6 length of an initial permit so that a permit is not issued for a period of more than
7 five years [IS VALID FOR FIVE YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE].

8 * **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
9 read:

10 APPLICABILITY. AS 18.65.700(d), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to
11 permits issued and renewed after the effective date of this Act.
