* **Sec. 4.** STATE PARTICIPATION IN THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009: INTENT. It is the intent of the legislature to acknowledge the extraordinary one-time nature of the appropriations made

(1) in P.L. 111-5 (American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009), and to recognize that similar federal appropriations will not likely recur; and

(2) through the state appropriations financed by P.L. 111-5 (American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009) in the budgets of state agencies, the University of Alaska, and other entities of the executive branch, and to recognize that similar state appropriations will not likely recur.
