A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to emergency compensation from the Violent Crimes Compensation**
2 **Board."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 18.67.120 is amended to read:

5 **Sec. 18.67.120. Emergency compensation.** If it appears to the board, prior to
6 taking action on an application, that the claim is one for which compensation is
7 probable, and undue hardship will result to the applicant if immediate payment is not
8 made, the board may make an emergency award of compensation to the applicant
9 pending a final decision in the case. However,

10 (1) the amount of the emergency compensation may not exceed **\$3,500**
11 **[\$1,500];**

12 (2) the amount of the emergency compensation shall be deducted from
13 the final compensation made to the applicant;

14 (3) the excess of the amount of the emergency compensation over the

1 final amount shall be repaid by the applicant to the board.
