A RESOLUTION

1 **Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State**
2 **Legislature, concerning House Bill No. 369, relating to an in-state natural gas pipeline,**
3 **the office of in-state gasline project manager, and the Joint In-State Gasline**
4 **Development Team; requiring the development of an in-state natural gas pipeline plan,**
5 **to be delivered to the legislature by July 1, 2011, that provides for a gasline that is**
6 **operational by December 31, 2015; directing the Joint In-State Gasline Development**
7 **Team to assume responsibilities under sec. 19, ch. 14, SLA 2009; and requiring**
8 **expedited review and action by state agencies or entities relating to the in-state natural**
9 **gas pipeline project.**

10 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

11 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of
12 Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding
13 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of House Bill No. 369, relating to

1 an in-state natural gas pipeline, the office of in-state gasline project manager, and the Joint In-
2 State Gasline Development Team; requiring the development of an in-state natural gas
3 pipeline plan, to be delivered to the legislature by July 1, 2011, that provides for a gasline that
4 is operational by December 31, 2015; directing the Joint In-State Gasline Development Team
5 to assume responsibilities under sec. 19, ch. 14, SLA 2009; and requiring expedited review
6 and action by state agencies or entities relating to the in-state natural gas pipeline project.
