**A RESOLUTION**

1 **Establishing a Senate Special Committee on World Trade, Technology, and Innovations.**

2 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:**

3 **WHEREAS** world trade is of increasing importance to the economy of the state; and

4 **WHEREAS** legislation enacted by the federal government has far reaching effect on  
5 the economy of the state; and

6 **WHEREAS** there is renewed interest in the United States Congress in exploring the  
7 ramifications of federal legislation on the states and their economies; and

8 **WHEREAS** the legislature should take an active role in exploring opportunities to  
9 promote world trade and assist the United States Congress in understanding the effect of  
10 federal legislation on the state's economy;

11 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Senate that a Senate Special Committee on World Trade,  
12 Technology, and Innovations is established to study issues relating to world trade, technology,  
13 and innovations; and be it

14 **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the president of the Senate shall determine the number  
15 of senators to be members of the committee and shall appoint the members and designate a  
16 member to chair the committee; and be it

1           **FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Senate Special Committee on World Trade,  
2 Technology, and Innovations may meet during and between sessions of the Twenty-Sixth  
3 Alaska State Legislature and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the  
4 Twenty-Seventh Alaska State Legislature.
