This bill would make changes to existing statues dealing with property tax exemptions for law enforcement officers living in high crime areas, widow or widowers of disabled veterans, certain non-profit colleges and universities and a raise in the property tax exemption amount. Sections 1 and 2 of bill will extend a property tax exemption for the Delong Mountain Transportation System at the Red Dog mine in Northwest Arctic Borough. The Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development does not anticipate a fiscal impact to the department due to passage of this legislation. However, potential fiscal impact to municipalitites will vary and are not reflected in this fiscal note.
