This bill amends AS 04.16.050(b-d) by clarifying when a person is guilty of repeat or habitual minor consuming or in possession or control. This bill changes AS 04.16.200 by increasing the penalties for violation of AS 04.16.200(b) or (2) or (3), and AS 04.11.499(h).

Passage of this legislation will not increase the number of arrests made or cases referred for prosecution. This bill will have no fiscal impact on the department.
