Senate Bill 47 suspends for one year the statue of limitation that would otherwise apply to civil actions for past sexual abuse. While this bill is likely to result in more cases being filed with the court system, it will also result in fewer hearings for existing cases when the plaintiff argues that the current statute of limitations should be tolled in his of her particular case. Although it is a difficult to accurately weigh these factors, it is likely that any increase in cases filed will be offset by fewer hearings in current and future cases. Because of this, the court system does not anticipate a fiscal impact from the passage of this SB 47.
