This bill provides conformity between Alaska's elective share and testamentary proof provisions in Alaska's Uniform Probate Code with those adopted in the 2009 amendments to the official Uniform Probate Code. It ensures that irrevocable trusts with transfer restrictions are excluded from the augmented estate. Finally, it allows petitioners to determine the validity of wills and trusts prior to the death of the settler and establishes the procedures to be followed in accomplishing this. No anticipated fiscal impact to Department of Law.
