This bill continues a maximum \$1.00 per kilowatt-hour cap for power costs paid by the Power Cost Equalization (PCE) program.

This fiscal note is informational only because the open-ended language in the operating budget bill [Sec. 11(e), HB 81] appropriates the GF necessary to fund the PCE Program. However, the \$5.5 million above represents the additional funding needed for the PCE program if the bill passes. The Governor's budget currently contains \$32.16 million. The total funding needed if this bill passes is anticipated to be \$37.66 million.

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
