ANALYSIS CONTINUATION

SB 190 would expand privacy interests in information that is not currently considered to be private – such as fingerprints and facial characteristics. This information is described as biometric information. It provides that a private entity could be prosecuted for a crime or sued civilly, or both, for disclosing information without the written consent of the subject of the information.

The definition of biometric information is potentially very broad and includes information based on a person's behavioral characteristics. Because of the possible breadth of the information included, distribution of which would be subject to criminal prosecution without permission of the person, the Department of Law submits an indeterminate note. We will be working with other agencies to determine whether we can make a more specific estimate of the costs of SB 190.
