Thirty-first Day

Pursuant to adjournment the House was called to order by Speaker Chenault at 11:02 a.m.

JOINT SESSION IN THE HOUSE

In accordance with Uniform Rule 51, Speaker Chenault turned the gavel over to President Stevens who called the joint session to order at 11:02 a.m.

The purpose of the joint session was to hear an address by the Honorable Lisa Murkowski, U.S. Senator.

Senator Ellis moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the Senate be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

Representative Johansen moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the House be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

President Stevens appointed Representative Wilson and Senator Davis to escort the Honorable Lisa Murkowski to the joint session.

The Senate Sergeant-at-Arms announced the Senator's entrance into the House Chamber.

Senator Murkowski was escorted to the rostrum and welcomed by President Stevens.

Senator Murkowski delivered her address, and it is published in House and Senate Joint Journal Supplement No. 4.

A question and answer period followed the conclusion of the Senator's speech.

Senator Murkowski received a standing ovation and was escorted from the Chamber by Representative Wilson and Senator Davis.

Senator Ellis moved and asked unanimous consent that the joint session adjourn. There being no objection, President Stevens adjourned the joint session at 12:07 p.m.
