Those covered by the Legislative Ethics Act are required to disclose their close economic associations, in sufficient detail, with supervisors, legislators, public officials defined in AS 39.50, registered lobbyists and, if the discloser is a legislator, with legislative employees.

An **exception** to that rule is **gifts of travel and hospitality to obtain (or provide) information on matters of legislative concern.** A person who accepts a gift of over \$250 under the "matters of legislative concern" exception must disclose receipt of the gift.

Travel paid for by state agencies must be disclosed.
