EXPLANATION: This exclusively federal funding is aimed at getting low-income students and students from under-represented groups into college. The funding provides “near peer” mentoring by recent college graduates to students near high school graduation. The mentor help youth apply for financial aid, college enrollment, or explore other career paths. This federal funding would allow the program to expand from Anchorage-only to Bethel, with the intent of expanding to rural areas as possible.
