Amendment to HB 160 Description

This amendment expands the group that directs the tourism marketing campaign to thirteen members comprised of:

- One member from the cruise industry appointed by the governor for a three year term
- Six members as already described in the bill in which each judicial district must be represented by at least one member. Of the six, two members have to represent small businesses (less than 50 employees), one member has to be from a medium-sized business (51-250 employees), and one member has to be from a large business (more than 250 employees)
- Six members representing the different areas of the tourism industry: two from lodging, two from transportation, and two from activities (ie tours, goldpanning, etc.)
