**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act establishing the fourth Saturday of July each year as Ted Stevens Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.067. Ted Stevens Day.** Ted Stevens Day is established on the  
5 fourth Saturday of July each year to honor Theodore F. "Ted" Stevens, whose long  
6 record of public service includes 40 years as a United States senator from Alaska, for  
7 his service to the state and the nation. Ted Stevens Day may be observed by suitable  
8 observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
